



## **Licenses for EU citizens and their family members from 2 August 2021**

- 1. Registration certificate for EU, UK, Norway, Switzerland, Iceland and Liechtenstein citizens**
  - replaces the original temporary residence certificate from 2 August 2021
    - a. Citizens of the EU, Norway, Switzerland, Iceland and Liechtenstein - Registration certificate without biometric data valid for 10 years
    - b. UK nationals covered by the Exit Agreement - Registration certificate in the form of a residence permit card with biometric data valid for 5 years
  
- 2. The temporary residence permit (family members of EU, Czech, UK, Norwegian, Swiss, Iceland and Liechtenstein citizens) is issued in the form of:**
  - a. **Residence cards (= valid for up to 5 years)**
    - close family members of EU nationals
    - close family members of Czech citizens who have executed the right of free movement\*

*Validity is based on the expected residence of the EU/Czech citizen.*
  - b. **Residence permit (= usually valid for up to 3 years)**
    - all family members of Czech citizens (except close family members of Czech citizens who have executed the right of free movement)
    - all family members of UK citizens (valid for up to 5 years)
    - all family members of citizens of Norway, Switzerland, Iceland and Liechtenstein
    - distant family members of EU citizens
  
- 3. Permanent residence for citizens of the EU, the UK, Norway, Switzerland, Iceland and Liechtenstein is issued in the form of:**
  - a. **Permanent residence permit without biometric data (= validity 10 years)**
    - Citizens of the EU, Norway, Switzerland, Iceland and Liechtenstein
  - b. **Permanent residence permit with biometric data (= validity 10 years)**
    - UK nationals covered by the Exit Agreement
  
- 4. Permanent residence (family members of EU, Czech, UK, Norway, Switzerland, Iceland and Liechtenstein citizens) is issued in the form of:**
  - a. **Permanent residence cards**
    - close family members of EU nationals
    - close family members of Czech citizens who have executed the right of free movement\*
  - b. **Residence permit**
    - to all distant family members
    - close family members of Czech citizens who have not executed the right of free movement\*
    - family members of nationals of Norway, Switzerland, Iceland and Liechtenstein and the United Kingdom

\* a close family member of a citizen of the Czech Republic who has executed free movement -> who follows or accompanies a citizen of the Czech Republic back to the territory and if they have been living together for a long time in another Member State of the European Union
