APPLICATION - ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Each university or faculty may have different deadlines for submitting applications for study, conditions for study and conditions for admission. All the necessary information can be found on the website of the specific university.

In general, most universities accept applications for study until 28 February of the calendar year.

An overview of universities (public, state, private, foreign) can be found here:

Entrance exams:

- They take place during May and June (the candidate will receive an invitation).
- The process of the entrance examination varies.
- By the beginning of the summer holidays, each applicant should be notified whether or not he or she has been accepted for study.
- During the summer holidays July and August universities announce the 2nd round of entrance exams for some fields of study. However, this happens only in case of free capacity.

If you take the SCIO tests, you can take a mock test here:

Application:

- It is usually electronic (you may be required to print out the application form and deliver it by post, to the study department, including proof of payment of the administrative fee).
- The form can be found on the website of the specific university (E-application).
- An administrative fee of 600 900 CZK is required for each application, depending on the specific conditions of the school.
- The application form should be filled in with: full name, address of residence, birth certificate number, name of the university, faculty and field of study, details of the secondary school
