Every person is obliged to pay health insurance to the relevant health insurance company!

If they don't pay it, the insurance company will incur a debt (penalty). Thanks to these payments, everyone is assured of medical care and other health services related to it.

- If you are working (employed), your employer must pay the insurance for you.
- If you are not working (unemployed) and you are on the register of jobseekers (permanent residents only), the state pays the insurance for you.
- If you are not working (unemployed) and are not on the jobseeker's register (only permanent residents), you pay your health insurance.

In the Czech Republic, a distinction is made between PUBLIC health insurance and COMMERCIAL health insurance.

- The "HEALTH INSURANCE CARD" serves as proof of health insurance and must be carried at all times. In the case of commercial insurance, proof of payment must also be carried.

! We recommend that you check the list of contracted doctors before signing up for insurance. You may find that your doctor will ask for cash for treatment. In this case, get a bill and proof of payment. After you have submitted the documents to the insurance company, the insurance company will reimburse you for the care.
