## CHANGES IN THE PAYMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE FEES FROM JANUARY 1 2025!

## AS OF 31 DECEMBER 2024, ALL REVENUE STAMPS WILL NO LONGER BE VALID

From 1 January 2025, administrative fees can be paid using the following methods:

- Payment at the Ministry of the Interior's offices via payment terminals. These offices will no longer accept cash payments for administrative fees.
- Payment by bank transfer. For applications submitted remotely, users will be able to
  access a feature on the Information Portal for Foreigners, which will generate the
  required payment details.

Applications with revenue stamps can be submitted in person or remotely only until 31 December 2024. If your application contains revenue stamps after this date, you will be required to pay the administrative fee, as revenue stamps will no longer be valid.

An administrative fee is a charge for an action performed by the Ministry of the Interior of the Czech Republic. A list of all administrative fees can be found here:
