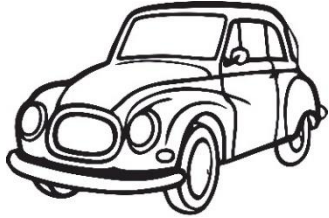


DO YOU HAVE A CAR THAT DOES NOT HAVE A CZECH LICENCE PLATE (SPZ)?

ATTENTION! THE VEHICLE MUST BE REGISTERED IN THE CZECH REPUBLIC!



THE OBLIGATION TO REGISTER A VEHICLE IN THE CZECH REPUBLIC APPLIES TO:

- **Foreigners from third countries who reside in the Czech Republic for more than 90 days (long-term visa, long-term residence, or permanent residence).**

Registration is not required if the vehicle is taken out of the EU within six months (185 days).

- **Persons from Ukraine with temporary protection.** (<https://md.gov.cz/Zivotni-situace/Registr-vozidel/Evidence-ukrajinskych-vozidel>)



To register your vehicle, you need:

- Technical inspection of the vehicle
- Liability insurance for the operation of the vehicle (so-called compulsory insurance, also known as a green/white card)
- Technical certificate
- Clearance certificate.
 - o Without confirmation from the customs office, vehicle registration is not possible (or confirmation of exemption from customs duties).
- The vehicle must be deregistered in the country of origin.



Vehicle registration is carried out at the municipal office with extended jurisdiction - vehicle registry.
