

ATTENTION!

IDENTITY DOCUMENTS MUST BE CARRIED AT ALL TIMES

It is the duty of every citizen of the Czech Republic to present his/her identity card when requested by an authorised person.

IDENTITY CARD is a document that states:

- name and surname,
- date of birth,
- place of permanent residence or residence outside the Czech Republic,
- photo.

Foreigners with a visa sticker and foreigners staying in the Czech Republic on the basis of visa-free travel shall prove their identity with a travel document.

Foreigners who have been issued a residence permit (biometric card) in the Czech Republic must present a biometric card (they do not need a travel document at the same time).

Foreigners who have a residence permit in another EU country and are in the Czech Republic for a short period of time only (depending on the type of stay), must present their residence permit and travel document.

In addition to your ID card, you also need to carry your health insurance card. Remember that if you have commercial health insurance, you also need to carry proof of payment.
